Pierre-Charles Pradier is associate professor at Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne University. He has been the dean of the economics department, before serving as vice-provost, then dean of the national school of insurance (ENAss/CNAM). Since 2016, he has been chairing the terminology committee with the French Economics Ministry (<http://terminologie2017.ministere-eco-finances.fr/>) and the ReFi+ Graduate School project for the LabEx RéFi (<http://www.labex-refi.com/>).

He has authored numerous papers on the economics of risk in a historical perspective as well as financial regulation, and two books: *Le risque en théorie économique* (which was awarded the 2007 *Risques* award) and *Financial Regulation in the EU from Resilience to Growth* (with Raphaël Douady and Clément Goulet, Palgrave Macmillan).
